Give Parents A Break 2025 Contract

The Give Parents A Break program is funded by the Air force Aid Society and is designed to provide relief for active duty Air Force parents who have family members deployed or TDY, have an emergency situation such as illness of a family member, recently moved to base or other unique circumstances.

What do I need?

- 1. Completed referral form provided by the Military & Family Readiness Center.
- 2. Turn referral into the Child Development Center (CDC) or the Youth Center along with completing the registration requirements in CYP-BMS.CYP programs also requires a copy of your child's immunization records (most updated to include the flu shot).
- 3. Registration requirements must be completed <u>NO LATER THAN TWO WEDNESDAYS BEFORE THE SCHEDULED GPAB</u> in order to save a slot for your child.

- CDC children will take naps. (You may bring a blanket or snuggly toy for your child)
- Please dress children appropriately for outdoor play. (You may want to bring an extra set of clothes.)
- <u>REMINDER</u>: You cannot sign up for GPAB until you have completed all registration requirements. THE REFERRAL COMES FROM M&FRC and needs to be provided to the program. Sign-ups are due TWO WEDNESDAYS before the event.
