## Transition Assistance

### Pre-Separation Counseling

This session provides you with vital information on benefits, VA services, and available resources.

### 3-Day TAP Workshop

A mandatory program that equips transitioning service members with the knowledge, skills, and resources needed to successfully move from military to civilian life, covering career planning, VA benefits, and financial readiness.

### Education Track

The education workshop guides you through opportunities for further education, including VA benefits, scholarships, and financial aid to help you pursue your educational goals.

### Employment Track

The Department of Labor employment workshop helps you identify civilian job opportunities, improve your resume, and practice interview skills. This workshop ensures you're job ready.
