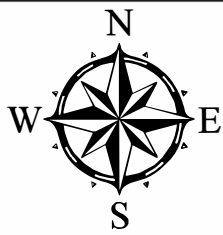

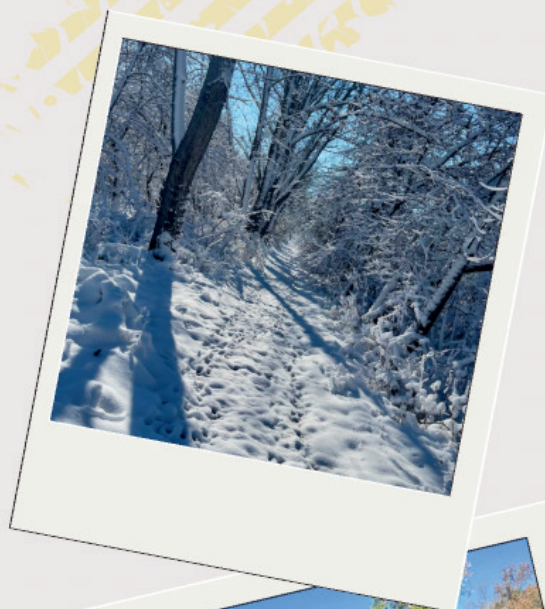

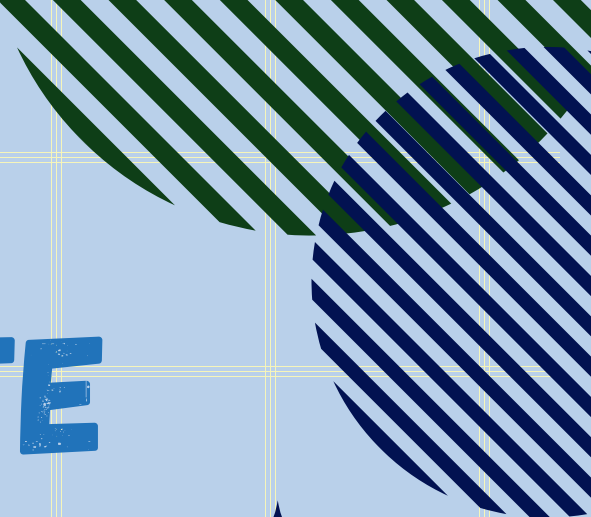
Those who are arriving to GFAFB and need children's items should consider checking out Airman's Attic, also found in building 207. Airman's Attic is free and runs off of donated items.

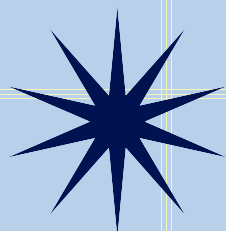

SPOUSE EMPLOYMENT

First Stop: M&FRC

Your first stop for employment assistance should be the M&FRC. Our team offers personalized support to help you achieve your career goals. Services include:

- One-on-one career counseling and planning.
- Free workshops on resume writing, interview skills, salary negotiation, and networking.
- Assistance with creating a tailored career action plan.
- Access to computers, printers, and other job search resources.

Financial Support for Your Career

Take advantage of programs designed to reduce the financial burden of career development and relocation:

- **SpouseWorks Scholarship** (formerly known as My Career Advancement Account (MyCAA) Scholarship): a scholarship for eligible spouses that provides up to \$4,000 in financial assistance for licenses, certifications, or associate degrees in portable career fields.
- **Licensure & Certification Reimbursement**: after a Permanent Change of Station (PCS), you may be reimbursed up to \$1,000 for costs to transfer your professional license or certification to a new state.
- **Small Business Relocation Reimbursement**: spouses who own a small business may be eligible for reimbursement of up to \$1,000 for relocation expenses incurred during a PCS.

Spouse Employment & Education Programs

These Department of War and partner programs are the cornerstones of spouse employment support:

- **SpouseWorks** (formerly known as Spouse Education and Career Opportunities or SECO): a comprehensive portal for career exploration, education, and training. Connect with a career coach and explore a vast array of resources.

Residents of government privatized housing who provide child care in their homes are required to become Air Force licensed FCC providers.





CHILD CARE for PCS



Supporting **Air Force and Space Force families** with child care assistance during the **Permanent Change of Station (PCS)** move process.

Eligibility

- ★ All Active-duty Air Force and Space Force members (Must apply within 60 days of arrival or departure)
- ★ Air National Guard and Reserve members activated under Title 10, USC for more than 15 days with a PCS order
- ★ Air Force and Space Force members with retirement, Palace Chase, or separation orders, including those on the Temporary Disability Retired List (TDRL) (Only eligible within 60 days at the departure location)

Program Benefits

- ★ **Financial Assistance**
\$200 per dependent child up to age 12 (not to exceed \$1,000 per household)
- ★ **Provider Flexibility**
Funds can be used for any child care option
- ★ **Direct Payment to Families**
Approved funds are deposited to member via Zelle or ACH

Documents Required

- ★ **PCS Order, Retirement Order, Separation Order**
(Eligible children must be listed on the PCS order and must be moving to the PCS location with the sponsor)
- ★ **Confirmation Form**
(Included in application process)
- ★ **Military ID**
(Copy of front & back)

IF TRAPPED IN A SNOW STORM:

1. Use your cellphone to call 911
2. Get the supplies needed from your trunk
3. Check the exhaust pipe for snow
4. Loosen tight clothing, remove metal jewelry, and layer extra clothing/blankets as needed

6. Open the downwind window slightly for ventilation
7. Burn a candle in a coffee can for heat
8. Set up flares/prepare to flash car lights
9. Eat a snack before sleeping and stay hydrated
10. Stay with your car until emergency services arrive

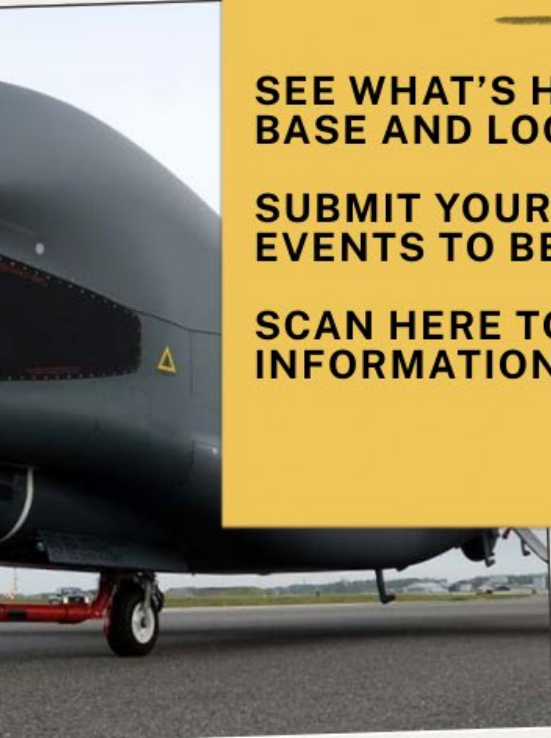
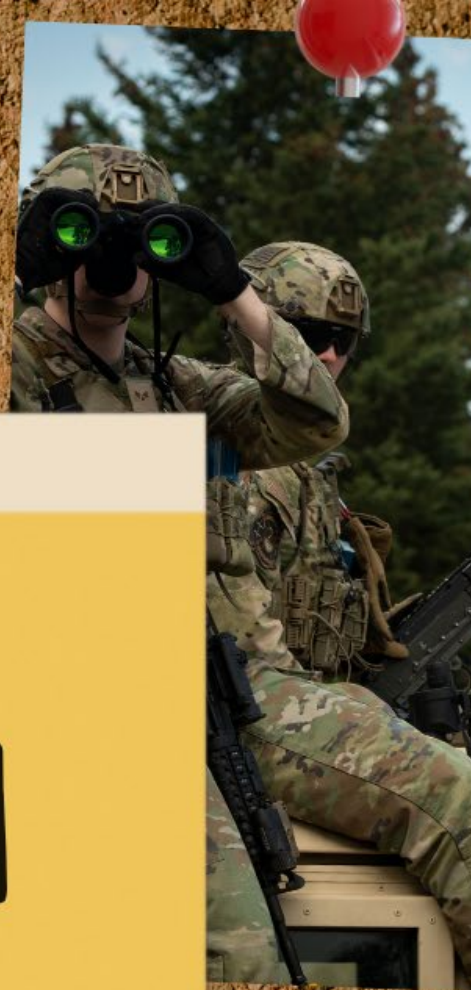

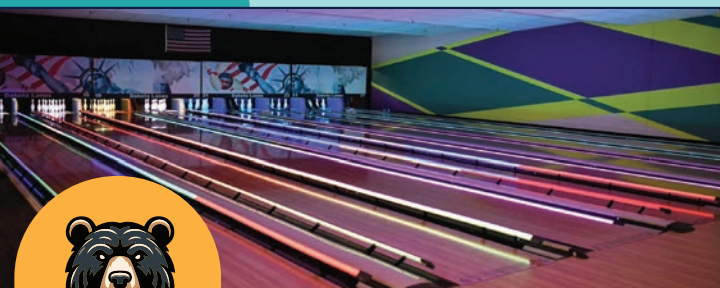
